Subject of Review:	The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) administers 16 domestic food and nutrition assistance programs that affect the lives of millions of people and account for roughly two-thirds of USDA's annual budget. In response to the Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic beginning in fiscal year (FY) 2020, USDA implemented additional temporary programs and numerous policy changes that expanded the scope and coverage of existing programs. As a result, participation in and spending on these programs changed substantially. This report examines trends in USDA's largest domestic food and nutrition assistance programs through FY 2023 (October 1, 2022– September 30, 2023). The report also documents policy changes in FY 2023 and trends in economic and social indicators affecting participation in and spending on food and nutrition assistance programs. In addition, it summarizes two recent USDA, Economic Research Service (ERS) reports: one examines the prevalence of household food insecurity in the United States in 2022; and another documents the share of households with school-aged children reporting difficulty paying for expenses after pandemic waivers allowing schools to serve free meals expired in 2022.
