The classification is mainly based on the farm's annual revenue, the main occupation of the farm's principal operator, and family versus nonfamily farm ownership. This report includes many sections that appear in each annual edition. Generally, data and statistics for these sections have varied little across the years as changes in the agricultural sector's structure are usually gradual. This edition reports the distribution of farm and non-farm pandemic assistance farms received in 2021 and enhances coverage of farm financial stress by including information on short-term debts and fungible assets. Authors also report on farm input purchase strategies, adoption of agritourism, and the percentage of farm household members with healthcare coverage.
