Preliminary Title: The Potential Impact of New Bread and Breakfast Cereal Products on U.S. Nutrient Consumption

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Subject of Review: A dynamic food supply makes dietary intake assessment and nutrition surveillance challenging. This study integrated market supply information with national dietary surveillance data to simulate these changes. We used product-level nutrition data from 2,207 new breakfast cereal products and 1,434 new bread products reported in Mintel Global New Products Database (GNPD) over the 2005-12 time period. The nutrients contained in new breakfast cereal and bread categories are integrated with nationally representative consumption patterns from the National Health and Nutrition Examination Survey to simulate potential impacts of new products on nutrient intakes.
