Changes to this risk – and thus to the federal government's fiscal exposure – are expected as weather averages and extremes change over the coming decades. This report uses a combination of statistical and economic modeling to simulate the impact of climate change on the cost of the existing Federal Crop Insurance, Agricultural Risk Coverage, and Price-Loss Coverage programs in the second half of the 21st century.
