Subject of Review: Americans spend about half of their total food budget to purchase about 70 percent of their food energy and weight of food from retail stores (e.g., grocery stores, supermarkets, supercenters, etc.). While many factors such as taste, level of convenience, and healthfulness impact food decisions, price is also an important factor. The Purchase to Plate Price Tool (PPPT) uses retail or household scanner data to estimate prices for foods Americans report eating in the dietary intake study, What We Eat in America/National Health and Nutrition Examination Survey (WWEIA/NHANES). Researchers can also use the tool with a subset of the scanner data to produce prices appropriate for their research question. This allows researchers to harness the wealth of information in WWEIA/NHANES to examine the role of food prices.
