The U.S. Department of Agriculture's Economic Research Service (ERS) periodically reports on research findings relevant to WIC policy and program operations, often following major changes in the program's design, with the last such report being in 2015. This report explains how WIC works, discusses program trends, and summarizes ERS research findings on key economic and policy issues facing the program, particularly those related to temporary changes to the program during the COVID-19 pandemic and ongoing infant formula supply chain disruptions.
