Subject of Review: Addressing the digital divide between rural and urban areas and across demographic and socioeconomic groups is a high priority for the Administration and Congress. More than \$50 billion has been invested to date by Federal broadband programs and more than \$85 billion of additional investment is planned under the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act of 2021 and the Rural Digital Opportunities Fund of the Federal Communication Commission (FCC). Despite the high priority of this issue, no published research has investigated the incidence of these programs – i.e., who is benefitting from the programs. This study seeks to begin to address this information gap, focusing on the incidence of three USDA broadband programs – the Broadband Initiatives Program (BIP), the Community Connect Grant (CCG) Program, and the ReConnect Program (RCP).
